This matter came before this Court in July of 2005 on the Petition of Cat Champion Corporation for a limited protective order pursuant to ORS 125.650(4). After this Court initially denied the Petition, Petitioner appealed to the Oregon Court of Appeals, which reversed and remanded to this Court to enter a final order granting the Petition as requested. Therefore, it now appears to the Court from the records and files herein that:

1. Venue for this protective proceeding lies in this county and no other court in this state has acquired jurisdiction over this proceeding.
2. Notice of this protective proceeding has been given to the parties entitled to such notice pursuant to Oregon law. The time for filing objections herein has expired with no objections having been filed.
3. This Court finds by clear and convincing evidence that the Respondent is incapacitated and issuance of a protective order as requested is necessary and in the best interests of the Respondent, as well as the best interests of the subject cats.

4. Cat Champion Corporation is the most suitable entity to act on behalf of Respondent in this matter. Cat Champion Corporation is qualified and has consented to act as Respondent's fiduciary. Now, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

1. That Cat Champion Corporation is appointed as a fiduciary for the 11 cats previously in Respondent's custody for the limited purpose of providing for their care and permanent placement, in a manner that best serves the cats' interests;
2. That due to the fragile health of the cats that they continue to endure as a result of actions taken by Respondent, Petitioner does not expect to be able to charge any adoption fee in placement of the cats. Further, because Petitioner has expended costs in an amount exceeding \$32,000, any adoption fees that they do happen to recover may be applied toward those costs.
